Props Policy

We welcome props that are safe for public events. However, for the safety and comfort of all attendees, please do not bring:

- Realistic-looking weapons
- Large or heavy objects
- Airsoft guns or similar weapon replicas
- Props made from wood or heavy metal
- Sharp or dangerous props

If you are unsure whether your prop is suitable, we recommend adding an orange safety tip where appropriate.

Please note that event staff reserve the right to:

- Refuse entry to unsafe props
- Remove props deemed dangerous during the event

This includes anything that may:

- Damage vehicles

- Create safety risks
- Make other attendees feel uncomfortable or unsafe

Our goal is to ensure everyone can enjoy the event in a safe, relaxed, and welcoming environment.
